SAINT PAUL'S UNIVERSALIST CHURCH of LITTLE FALLS, NY

2016 marked the 165th anniversary of St. Paul's Universalist Unitarian Church. May 3, 1851 was the date when the church was formally organized as the First Universalist Society at Rockton. However, the roots of Universalism in this area go back to 1814 when a society was formed at Eaton's Bush. Preachers occasionally came to Little Falls and by the 1830's, a definite attempt was made to establish a church here. In 1848, the Rev. J.H. Harter became the first settled minister of Universalism in Little Falls. During his ministry, the present organization was formed. The building in which we worship today was dedicated on June 9, 1868. Weekly worship is held every Sunday from Labor Day to the middle of June at 10:00am. New members are always welcomed.
